E-470 Takes Important Steps to Ensure Continued Financial Stability *ExpressToll and License Plate Toll Rates Frozen through 2021*

Aurora, Colorado – E-470’s Board of Directors voted unanimously on May 14, 2020, to reaffirm the ExpressToll rate freeze first implemented on January 1, 2018. The decision keeps 2017 toll rates in place for ExpressToll drivers on E-470 through 2021. License Plate Toll rates will also remain frozen through 2021 and remain at 2019 rates.

In addition to voting to freeze toll rates through 2021, the E-470 Board of Directors also approved updates to its debt management plan and bond resolutions enabling the Authority to move forward with a planned restructuring of its future debt service in 2020. The plan is to refund more than \$250 million to reduce and attempt to level the Authority’s annual debt service. The Authority plans to go to the market in the coming months.

“The actions taken by the Board of Directors represent a firm commitment to ensuring the continued financial stability and health of E-470, even in challenging times,” said E-470 Board Chair and Adams County Commissioner Chaz Tedesco. “Our financial stability allows us to support current and future improvements to the corridor that benefit our customers without raising toll rates.”

About the E-470 Public Highway Authority

E-470 is the 75-mph toll road running along the eastern perimeter of the Denver metropolitan area. E-470 is a user-financed roadway, receiving no local, state or federal funds for financing, construction, operations or maintenance. E-470 is a political sub-division of the state governed by the E-470 Public Highway Authority Board composed of eight local governments including Adams, Arapahoe and Douglas counties, and the municipalities of Aurora, Brighton, Commerce City, Parker and Thornton. E-470 also operates ExpressToll, the all-electronic toll collection system available on E-470, Northwest Parkway, and Colorado’s Express Lanes.
