



# A GUIDE TO COLORADO TOLL ROADS

Colorado offers many options for tolled lanes to provide the freedom of choice to drivers. ExpressToll provides a one-stop account management option for all roads. Visit each toll operator's website for additional information.



## E-470

- 47-mile nonstop, cashless, all-electronic toll highway that connects in the south to the I-25/C-470 interchange and connects in the north to the I-25/Northwest Parkway interchange
- 5 mainline toll plazas and several tolled ramp interchanges
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle
- Operated by the E-470 Public Highway Authority

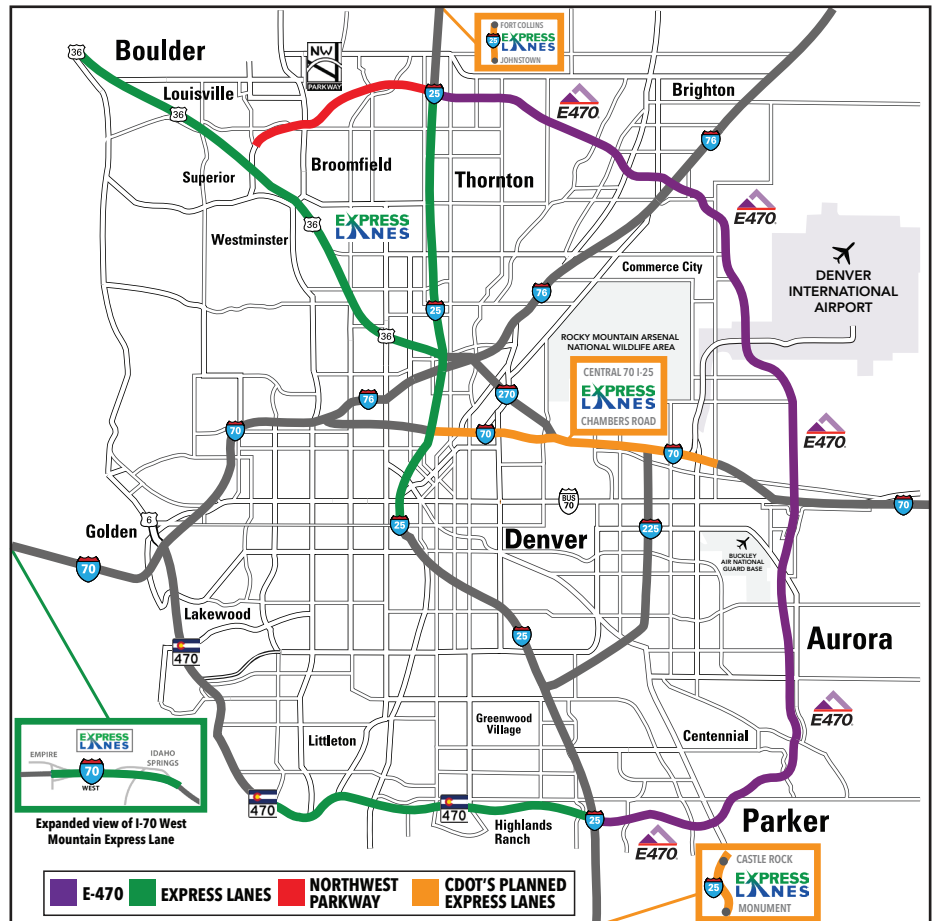
## Northwest Parkway

- 9-mile all-electronic public toll road connecting E-470 at I-25 with U.S. 36 in Broomfield
- 1 mainline toll location and 2 ramps
- Tolls collected through a Go Pass or ExpressToll account
- Operated by the Northwest Parkway Public Highway Authority

## CDOT Express Lanes

- Express Lanes increase roadway capacity and help manage congestion on Colorado highways by adding lanes that provide a new choice to drivers. Motorists can choose to ride the bus, carpool or pay a toll to use the Express Lanes as an alternative to the free general purpose lanes.

# A GUIDE TO COLORADO TOLL ROADS

## US 36

- 16 miles from Denver to Boulder
- 7 toll collection points
- Lanes open 24/7
- Dynamic toll pricing based on the time of day
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle
- HOV 3+ available with a switchable transponder

## C-470

- 12.5 miles between I-25 and Wadsworth Blvd.
- Lanes open 24/7
- Dynamic toll pricing based on the time of day
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle
- No HOV 3+ free travel

## I-70 Mountain Express Lane

- 13 miles eastbound from Empire through Veterans Memorial Tunnels
- Open weekends and holidays for a total of 100 days per year
- Dynamic toll price advertised is for the length of the entire Express Lane
- Toll-use only; no free motorcycle, carpool, trucks or trailers
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle

## I-25 Central

- Two reversible lanes between US 36 and downtown Denver
- Southbound lanes open 5-11 a.m.; northbound lanes open 12 p.m. - 3 a.m.; on weekends, northbound lanes open from noon Friday until 3 a.m. Monday
- Dynamic toll pricing based on the time of day
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle
- HOV 3+ available with a switchable transponder

## I-25 North - US 36 to 120th Ave.

- One lane in each direction between US 36 and 120th Ave.
- Lanes open 24/7
- Dynamic toll pricing based on the time of day
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle
- HOV 3+ available with a switchable transponder

## I-25 North - 120th Ave. to Northwest Parkway/E-470

- One lane in each direction between 120th Ave. and Northwest Parkway/E-470
- Lanes open 24/7
- Dynamic toll pricing based on the time of day
- Tolls collected through an ExpressToll account or License Plate Toll bill mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle
- HOV 3+ available with a switchable transponder
