A "Notice of Additional Evidence" form listing all additional evidence supporting your assertions and all witnesses you intend call at the hearing must also be filed, with all supporting documentation related thereto, and received by the Hearing Officer and the Complainant no later than 5 days prior to the hearing date, or such evidence will be inadmissible.
